Dear friends of Eagle River Golf Course,

Despite the pandemic, we had a successful golf season in 2020, thanks in no small way to our pre-paid guests. Thank you for your valued support.

We again invite you to participate in our season pass program which both saves you money on golf but also reduces the necessity of having to have face to face payment interactions with the pro-shop thereby minimizing the risk of virus transmission.

The ERGC Rate Card was simplified and daily fee rates were left largely unchanged. The early season and spring rates were combined, and the two rates were averaged out. Same thing in the fall where we combined and averaged the fall and late season rates. Some discounts were eliminated like the senior 10% daily fee discount and the family and college student rate.

Also, there will be no "before March 15<sup>th</sup>" discount for purchasing a season pass. There will now be one flat rate of \$825 for an adult season pass. This remains a great value for the golfer who plays fairly regularly. The cart season pass rose slightly, \$650 for a single and \$1100 for a couple.

If you don't think you might play enough to make the season pass worth it, you could opt for our Gold or Platinum cards. The Gold card is \$250 and gets you ½ off all green fees. The Platinum card costs \$450 and gets you ½ off all green fees *and* cart fees.

Our Superintendent, John Schultz retired at the end of the season, but we found a very capable replacement, Kyle Anderson, GCSAA. Kyle was the Superintendent at Steve Stricker's Towne Country Club in Edgerton, WI. He and I have discussed ways to improve the course, and he is very focused on the drainage problems on some holes here at ERGC. Kyle was one of 10 superintendents selected (out of 600 applicants) to help set up and maintain the Albatross Course of Le Golf National in Guyancourt, Paris, France for the 2018 Ryder Cup. He will also be performing the same duties at Whistling Straits, Kohler, WI for the postponed 2021 Ryder Cup.
