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SEPTEMBER SCHEDULE

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Remember to sign up for tee times before 4:00 PM on Sunday.

Sept 7th: 2:30: Shoot Out. Come one, come all to watch if you're not participating. There are currently 22 qualified with \$273 in winnings, CURRENTLY, so don't miss it!

4:00: Step Aside Scramble. Same as a Scramble, except the player whose ball is selected does not hit the next shot (i.e., she “steps aside”).

September 14: 9-Hole Horse Race: Teams of two will alternate shots from tee to hole. Teams will be made by placing the lowest and highest handicap players together, and moving towards the mid-handicaps.

One member of each team tees off on the first hole...thus the "horse race" to the green as each team alternates shots until their ball is holed out.

After the first hole, the highest scoring teams are eliminated, and the horse race continues to the second hole, where again the highest scoring teams are eliminated.

This format continues to the final hole (9th), with three teams remaining for the "Win, Place, & Show" finish. Teams that are eliminated are encouraged to follow the "race" and cheer on their favorite team.

If ties occur, a chip-off will determine which team(s) are eliminated.

The beverage cart will accompany us, and no greens fees will be charged.

Fall Meeting will follow the Horse Race, and then...

Final Banquet, celebrating not only the end of the season, but our **League's 50th Anniversary!** The Albatross will lay out a buffet dinner of chicken piccata over bow tie noodles, fried shrimp with cocktail sauce, various salads and dessert.

The cost is **\$25.00 including tip and tax** and this needs to be paid on September 7th by check or cash to Kay.

There is a sign up sheet on the board so we know how many to plan on.
